

## TRI-COUNTY CIRCUIT OPEN HORSE SHOW DEPARTMENT 15

### General Rules:

1. Read all rules governing the Otsego County Fair. They must be followed in addition to these general rules.
2. All equine native and out-of-state entered in exhibitions, expositions, or fairs must follow the MDA Health Requirements for Livestock Exhibited in Michigan.
3. Original coggins test with negative results required at gate upon arrival, IF required by the State.
4. Handlers & Riders of stallions must be 18 years old and older.
5. Due to MDA restrictions children 8 years old and under are non-competitive classes and will not receive a premium.
6. Exhibitor may be denied the privilege of showing if horse is considered dangerous, for abusive treatment of horse or unsportsmanlike behavior.
7. Any disputes will be decided by the show committee.
8. The Otsego County Fairgrounds are not responsible for loss or damage of personal property, horses, riders, etc.
9. You must bring your own bedding for stalls.
10. **REMEMBER!!** Register by mail and save \$1 per class. Entries are also taken the day of the show.
11. High Point Awards in conjunction with Cheboygan (August 6), Emmet-Charlevoix (August 13) and Otsego (August 20 - Prizes awarded). \$5 One Time Nomination Fee; payable at any of the three shows-One Horse, One Rider.
12. Nursing foals with Mares on the grounds with them do not require coggins. ALL others need a coggins, IF required by the State.
13. **WARNING** – Under the Michigan Equine Activity Liability Act, an equine professional or event sponsor, Otsego County Fairgrounds are not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in an equine activity resulting from an inherent risk of the equine activity.
